The Cincinnati Waldorf School is seeking a full-time Math Specialist for the 2024-25 school year. The ideal candidate will have experience teaching mathematical concepts at varied levels (from fractions and decimals to calculus), a willingness to learn and teach branches of math that traditionally are not taught at the primary and secondary levels, and experience or willingness to create courses and explore the historical and social context of mathematics in lessons. The candidate will be expected to embrace collaboration with colleagues. Experience and active interest in a place-based and multicultural curriculum reflecting our diverse community will be vital to success. A minimum of a Bachelor's degree is required and a Waldorf Grade School Teaching Certificate and previous Waldorf teaching experience are highly valued. We are willing to work with the right candidate who lacks this experience but is willing to pursue future training in Waldorf pedagogy. This is a full-time, salaried position with benefits, including tuition remission.
