Capacity for sight reading should be strong, along with ability to play intermediate to early advanced level Classical repertoire. Applicants should feel comfortable with simple improvisation that supports the mood of a story, form, or poem. Composition skills are not required but very useful. This is a part-time hourly position.

Making beautiful artistic music supports the Eurythmy movement in many ways, including musical development, listening, and enhancing the children's movements to be more beautiful and rhythmical.
